

FOUNTAIN CREEK NATURE CENTER & REGIONAL PARK



The nationally recognized nature center includes two adjoining parks with over 50 acres of marshes, grasslands, creek shores, ponds, and trails. Its location along Fountain Creek in the City of Fountain between I-25 and Highway 85 makes it easily accessible. The Fountain Creek Nature Center offers programs year around, and the Fountain Creek Regional Park has picnic grounds and connecting trails that stretch all the way to Denver. The parks are home to over 300 species of animals. The Fountain Creek Nature Center is one of the top 5 sites in the USA for migratory birds.

Families can walk the wetlands, search for great blue herons, and explore Fountain Creek. The creek shapes the landscape, and provides visitors with prime wildlife viewing opportunities. Call 719-520-6745 for more information or visit www.ElPasoCo.com/parks
