



# City of Fountain Fall Clean-Up



The City of Fountain will have Fall Clean-Up starting Sept. 7, 2016 through Sept. 16, 2016. Please do not put items out more than 24-hours prior to your scheduled day for pick-up. Any items left at or along the curbside, which are not intended for removal by the City, must be clearly marked. All items must be at the curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the day your area is scheduled for pick-up. City crews will not pick-up on private property.

**Once City crews have left scheduled areas they will not return.**

**WE WILL NOT PICK UP TREE STUMPS, PAINTS, LIQUIDS, BATTERIES, OIL, HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, ELECTRONICS (TV, COMPUTERS, LAPTOPS, VCR, ETC.), HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE, AND LARGE PILES OF DIRT OR DEBRIS.**

If regular garbage pickup is set for the same day as the City's Clean Up day, please separate and post a sign for all items intended for "City Clean Up."

Below are the ONLY items we charge for and must be paid prior to **September 2, 2016**:

Carpet Rolls	\$13 each
Full/Queen/King Mattress or Box Springs	\$20 each
Single/Twin Mattress or Box Springs	\$10 each
Couch/Overstuffed Chairs	\$20 each
Tires	\$5 each

**NOTE: ALL CHARGEABLE ITEMS MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO SEPTEMBER 2, 2016.**
