RE: Update - 2nd Arrest in Shooting – 7725 Fountain Mesa Road

Second Update

On June 1, 2020, a second arrest was made in this case. 18 year-old Haley Spencer was arrested and booked into the El Paso County Criminal Justice Center on the following charges: 1st Degree Assault, Tampering with Physical Evidence, Possession with Intent to Distribute (Marijuana), and Child Abuse.

Update

The investigation has led to the arrest of 21-year-old Domacio Ohlsen-Aragon. He has been charged with: 1st Degree Assault, Tampering with Physical Evidence, Possession with Intent to Distribute (Marijuana), and Child Abuse.

During the course of the investigation, Detectives learned Ohlsen-Aragon, and a female party, brought their 1-year-old child with them to an illegal drug transaction that took place at 7-11. As the investigation progresses, it is expected that more arrests will be made.

The 14-year-old was released from the hospital on May 26, with non-life threatening injuries. The 19-year-old is currently in stable condition.

Original

On May 26, 2020, at approximately 12:30 PM, officers with the Fountain Police Department (FPD) were dispatched to 7-11, located at 7725 Fountain Mesa Rd, for a reported shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a 19-year-old male with serious injuries from a gunshot wound and a 14-year-old male with minor injuries from a gunshot. Both were transported to a local hospital.

FPD's Investigations Division has assumed responsibility for the investigation. We are in the early stages of this investigation and will provide updates as soon as we have them. There is no threat to the public regarding this shooting.
