A controller will automatically adjust sprinkler run times based on weather, soil type, sprinkler type and plant types. Rebate is for up to \$50.00 or the cost of the controller, whichever is the lower amount. Visit **FountainUtilities.org** for a list of eligible *WaterSense* certified controllers.

Rain Sensor

Rain sensors adjust your irrigation based on weather conditions. Rebate is for up to \$25.00 or the cost of the sensor, whichever is the lower amount.

Rebate Requirements and Information

- Applicant must be a current Fountain Utilities water account holder. Account must be active and in good standing
- If applying for a Smart Controller Rebate, controller must be *WaterSense* certified. Rain sensors do not require WaterSense certification.
- The smart controller or rain sensor must be purchased new, not second-hand (used).
- Utility accounts are credited for the rebate amount. Allow up to two weeks for processing.
- Single family properties are eligible for one smart controller **or** rain sensor rebate every 10 years.
- To qualify for the program, application including copy of your receipt must be submitted within 90 days of purchase. The rebate program is first come, first served. Limited funds are dedicated for the program each year. When funds are exhausted, the program ends.
- Commercial, industrial, and multifamily rebates will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- All applicants must include: completed application, proof of lawful presence in the U.S. completed affidavit, copy of dated receipt and make/model number.
- The City of Fountain assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in this program.

APPLICANTS MUST ATTACH THE FOLLOWING:

- Copy of acceptable form of identification (image must be clear and text readable.)
- Copy of the receipt, make and model, or other identifying documentation from the appliance (do not include original receipt.)
