Real estate home showings can resume

Voluntary or elective medical, dental, and veterinary surgeries and procedures, per safety

guidelines

Friday, May 1 Retail businesses can phase-in a public opening, *per safety guidelines*

Monday, May 4 Offices can reopen at 50% reduced in-person staffing capacity, per safety guidelines

Businesses are encouraged to allow employees to continue telecommuting at higher levels

if possible Childcare facilities can also expand or reopen, per safety guidelines

- Simplified Criteria, Eligibility, and Application Form

- Applicable funds for Payroll, Rent, Utilities, Mortgage, etc.
