Colorado First and Existing Industry Customized Training Grants

In support of Colorado businesses affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Skill Advance Colorado FY 2020 COVID-19 Emergency Response Program provides State training funds for employee re-skilling and upskilling training efforts through Colorado First and Existing Industry grants.

## Grant funding supports COVID-19 response training for

- critical/essential business frontline employee re-training or upskilling
- workplace/employee safety
- food manufacturing safety
- workplace social distancing protocol
- manufacturing of personal protective equipment (PPE)

Other COVID-19 training will be considered.

Skill Advance-funded training implementation must be in compliance with current COVID-19 orders and guidelines issued by the Governor's Office, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, and local city and county governments / health departments.
