UNLAWFUL SEXUAL COMMUNICATION IN A POSITION OF TRUST

On October 13, 2022, the Fountain Police Department began an investigation into the report of an adult youth pastor sending sexually explicit material to a minor who attended his youth group. The investigation led to the arrest of 38-year-old, Jeffery Williams.

From 2013 to 2017, Williams was a pastor with the Salvation Army when it was located at 901 N. Santa Fe Ave in Fountain. Williams turned himself in to the Fountain Police Department on November 10, 2022 and was booked into the El Paso County Criminal Justice Center on the following charges: Unlawful Sexual Communication in a Position of Trust and Obscenity.
